



### General Festival Admission

DAILY: Adults and children 6 and older \$7, children 5 and under admitted free. CASH ONLY, no credit/debit cards. Sorry, no refunds. JULY 4TH: Active military and veterans: (with proof of status) are FREE all day. Lisle residents: (with proof of residency) are FREE before 3:00. COOLERS & OUTSIDE FOOD/DRINK ARE PROHIBITED.

Admission to the carnival is free, but there is a charge for the rides. **FREE CARNIVAL ADMISSION IS AVAILABLE FROM THE YACKLEY AVE (WEST ENTRANCE) ONLY.** SPECIAL TICKET PRICING WEDNESDAY, JULY 2ND: \$20 for unlimited rides from 5:00pm - 11:00pm or buy a MegaPass for unlimited rides all 5 days. \$50 in advance through June 30th by CREDIT CARD online at [www.EyesToTheSkies.org](http://www.EyesToTheSkies.org). AT THE GATE \$55, CASH ONLY.

### Directions

The festival is located on 110 beautiful acres in Lisle Community Park on Short St just West of Rte 53. From I-355, exit on Maple Ave West and follow the signs to parking. Going West on I-88, exit Rte 53 South and follow the signs to parking. Going East on I-88, exit Naperville Rd South. Take Naperville Rd to Ogden Ave East and follow the signs.

### Hotel Information


The Hilton Lisle/Naperville is the official hotel of the Lisle Eyes to the Skies Festival. The Hilton Lisle/Naperville offers a special room rate of \$79 per room, per night including breakfast for up to four people, not including tax. For reservations, call 800-552-2599 and ask for the Eyes to the Skies rate. Rate is based upon availability.

### Fireworks Schedule

Fireworks will begin at approximately 9:45pm each night. The July 4th fireworks will be extra special as they will be a spectacular extravaganza computerized to patriotic music. (All firework displays are subject to weather conditions and may be cancelled without notice.)

### Parking Information

Parking for the festival is \$5/car and there are spaces for more than 3,000 automobiles. Free shuttle buses take you to the festival entrance, from designated parking areas only. Many local businesses now sell parking spaces near to the EYES TO THE SKIES festival for more than \$5. Please understand that these lots are not connected with the Festival. Additionally, visitors are still required to pay an entrance fee. Exact change is appreciated. NO COOLERS OR OUTSIDE FOOD/DRINK.

### Motorcycle Parking

Special secured, premium parking for motorcycles is available for \$10. To reach the parking site, take Yackley Ave to Ohio St, turn east and follow staff directions to the attendant.

### Handicapped Parking

Handicapped accessible parking is available for \$5, but you must have handicapped license plates or a State of Illinois permit to qualify. To reach the handicapped parking, take Ogden Ave to Yackley Ave. Go South on Yackley to Ohio St where security personnel will direct you to the handicapped parking site.

### Serena's Song

Each day, "Serena's Song," the nation's first wheelchair accessible balloon, will be giving tethered rides to children and adults with disabilities from 6:00am - 7:30am and from 6:00pm until dusk Thursday through Saturday, weather permitting.
